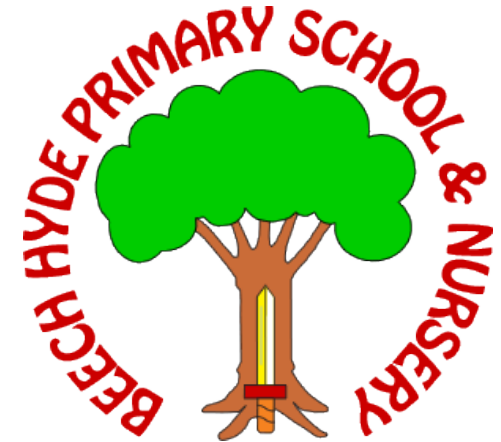
Mission Statement
