SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school colours are red and grey (not black) and we expect all pupils wear school uniform. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with the child's name.

WINTER

Boys

Grey trousers
Red buttoned polo shirt with Beech Hyde logo
Red sweatshirt with Beech Hyde logo
Grey socks

Girls

Grey skirt/pinafore dress. OR
Grey tailored trousers, no fashion trousers,
Red buttoned polo shirt with Beech Hyde logo
Red sweatshirt/cardigan with Beech Hyde logo
Grey or red tights/grey or white socks

SUMMER

Boys

Grey trousers or shorts
Red buttoned polo shirt with Beech Hyde logo
sweatshirt with Beech Hyde logo
Grey socks

Girls

Summer dress in small red gingham check
Red sweatshirt/cardigan with Beech Hyde logo
Red Grey skirt/shorts (knee length)
Red buttoned polo shirt with Beech Hyde logo
White socks

PE

Boys and Girls:

Red polo shirt or T-shirt
Green shorts
Plimsolls (for indoor PE)
Trainers (for outdoor PE) (Football boots are permitted during the winter)
School Tracksuits for the winter (alternatively plain grey or red tracksuits are allowed)
PE kit should be kept in a labelled bag with a separate bag for shoes

SHOES

Outdoor Shoes - All pupils are expected to wear smart black shoes which are to be worn to and from school (and for school events etc) which are outdoor shoes (**Ugg type boots, ankle boots and trainers are not acceptable**).
Indoor Shoes - All pupils are expected to wear indoor footwear - **ideally black plimsolls** or black soft shoes (Converse, Vans and slippers are not suitable)

EARRINGS

It is a County Council Health & Safety ruling that children should not wear earrings during PE and Games. Children who wear earrings are required to remove them during PE and Games.

HAIR

Extreme hairstyles are not to be worn in school. Distinctively styled hair or shaved heads have proven to be a distraction to some children and has an effect on attitudes which is not conducive to effective learning. Designs shaved into the hair and unnatural dyed hair should also not be worn during term time. Long hair should be tied back for school and especially for PE. For those children who need to tie back their hair they should use hair bands that are either: grey, red or black in colour.

ART

Every child (from Year 1 upwards) should have an old shirt (Velcro the collar and put elastic in sleeves) or a large overall to be worn during art/craft lessons.
