

<p><b><u>History/Geography</u></b>  <b>Geography-How does the geography of the amazon compare to where I live?</b></p> <p>We will locate the world's tropical rainforests. We will describe the differences of the UK and the Amazon. The children will develop an understanding of the different layers of the rainforest and the types of homes that the people live in.</p> <p><b>History – Telephones</b></p> <p>Pupils will learn about and compare telephones. They will investigate how they have developed. They will learn about Alexander Graham Bell.</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b>  <b>Hands, Feet and Heart / Christmas production</b></p> <p>The children will develop confidence in singing and establish a clear understanding of both rhythm and pulse. They will use physical movements to enhance sense of rhythm and will learn songs associated with the our Charanga scheme of work.  Year 2 will be learning Christmas songs using a variety of rhythms and pitch.</p> <p><b><u>PE</u></b>  <b>Fitness/Ball skills-</b> In P.E the children will be learning to work in pairs, small groups and as a team in fitness and exercise games. In skills they will be developing their feet skills. PE lessons will be taught by Mr Drake and will take place on a Monday and Tuesday. We will also complete the Daily Mile.  Trainers and PE kit should be in school every day.</p> <p><b><u>Computing</u></b>  <b>We are Detectives-Collecting Clues</b></p> <p>Pupils will develop confidence in logging on and off a computer and begin to locate letters on the keyboard. They will gain and develop skills in opening, composing and sending emails.  <b>We are astronauts- Programming on screen</b></p> <p>The children will be developing skills in creating simple programmes using a programmable toy, such as beebots</p>		<p><b><u>English</u></b>  <b>Rainforest-The Great Kapok Tree</b></p> <p>This term year 2 will be studying a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. In Autumn 1 stories linking to our topic The Rainforest, looking closely at 'The Great Kapok Tree' by Lynne Cherry. This will lead to a number of exciting writing opportunities for the children including letters, story settings and our own rainforest adventure stories.</p> <p><b>Space-Man on the Moon</b></p> <p>In Autumn 2 texts link to their topic 'Space'. They will focus on the story 'Man on the Moon' and learn how to use a range of punctuation in their information writing, discovering commas, speech marks and apostrophes. They will look closely at the four types of sentences: questions, exclamations, commands and statements. When it gets a little closer to Christmas we will be writing letters to Father Christmas.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> will be taught through our main English lessons as well as in discrete lessons.</p>

<p><b><u>Science</u></b>  <b>Habitats Rainforest:</b></p> <p>Our Autumn 1 topic will be The Rainforest. We will look at the people, animals and plants that inhabit the world's rainforests, focusing in detail on The Amazon Rainforest. We will learn about food chains, and identify and name different sources of food.</p> <p><b>Every Day Materials-Materials for different uses</b></p> <p>Year 2 will be soaring into Space the second half of Autumn term! The children will learn to identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.</p>	<p><b><u>Art/Design and Technology</u></b>  <b>Art– Make a rainbow</b></p> <p>Pupils will study the work and use drawing, painting and sculpture in the style of Paul Klee and Wassily Kandinsky. They will develop their techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.</p> <p><b>DT-Vehicles</b></p> <p>Mechanisms- Wheels and axles  Making/drawing plans and evaluations.</p>	<p><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>Pupils will learn about Christianity beliefs and practices and will compare these with Judaism.</p> <p><b><u>PSHCE</u></b>  <b>Being Me in My World / Celebrating Difference</b></p> <p>Separate document attached</p>	
<p><b><u>Mathematics</u></b></p> <p>Key skills this term include comparing and ordering 2 &amp; 3 digit numbers using &lt; and &gt;. They will be revising important number bonds to solve addition and subtraction problems. The children will then be learning to double and halve numbers and will learn to work systematically to find possible answers to problems. Children will be encouraged to use using concrete and pictorial representations.</p>
