

<p>History/Geography</p> <p>History – The Vikings: Pupils will learn about when and where Viking attacks took place. They will investigate longships and will learn about daily life and Viking gods and goddesses. They will learn how historians interpret archaeological evidence.</p> <p>Geography – Volcanoes: We will learn about the formation of volcanoes and describe a volcanic eruption. Pupils will learn to describe geographical features, including physical and human features. They will find out about the effect on humans.</p>	<p>Music Happy / Classroom Jazz 2 Pupils will have the opportunity to sing and play musically. They will develop their understanding of musical compositions and will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts. They will listen to and appraise a range of music.</p> <p>PE Football, Netball, Dance: Haka PE lessons will be taught by Mr Drake and will take place on a Thursday and Friday. We will also complete the Daily Mile. Trainers and PE kit should be in school every day.</p> <p>MFL Healthy Lifestyle / Alphabet: Spelling Bee Activities will include naming a variety of foods and identifying activities helpful for a healthy lifestyle. They will be learn the alphabet and be given the opportunity to participate in the annual Beech Hyde Spelling Bee.</p> <p>Computing iProgram Pupils will develop their programming skills using Scratch to design and program their own game of 'Pong'. They will then create their own game inspired by our reading of Alice in Wonderland.</p>		<p>English</p> <p>We will begin our English work with 'Journey to the River Sea'. Our writing will include setting descriptions, informal letters, travel brochures and a journey story.</p> <p>After half-term, we will study 'Alice in Wonderland' where we will begin to look at portal stories. Pupils will write formal letters, an account of a trial and a story.</p> <p>We will look at a range of text types in our whole class guided reading, focusing on fluency and comprehension.</p> <p>Grammar will be taught through our main English lessons as well as in discrete lessons.</p>
