PUNCTUALITY REMINDER

On Tuesday this week, 16 pupils arrived late for school. Here is a little reminder as to the impact of frequent lateness.

LATE ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL

When your child arrives late at school, he/she misses the teacher's instructions, the introduction to the lesson & ordering lunch.

Your child may also feel embarrassed at having to enter the classroom late

Minutes late per day during the	Equals days worth of teaching
school year	lost in a year
5 Minutes	3.4 Days
10 Minutes	6.9 Days
15 Minutes	10.3 Days
20 Minutes	13.8 Days
30 Minutes	20.7 Days

Frequent lateness can add up to a considerable amount of learning lost, and can seriously disadvantage your child.

FAMILY TOOLKIT COURSE

As a result of the feedback from our parental engagement survey, we would like to introduce a 4 week course - 'The Family Toolkit'. The course will run from 21 November 2023 until 12 December, and will be from 1-3pm in the Nursery classroom. It will be run by the Harpenden Plus Network, part of the Families First partnership.

The family toolkit covers;

- understanding your child's needs; how we communicate
- nurturing relationships in the home: praise and encouragement and family wellbeing
- understanding and managing behaviour; rules and routines and dealing with conflict
- Choices and consequences; behaviour to ignore and Nurturing ourselves

It is based on 4 constructs which are Self esteem/ self awareness, appropriate expectations (of our children and ourselves), discipline/ boundaries and empathy.
