Dear Parents / Carers,

Another packed week at Beech Hyde saw our summer term clubs start and it was so wonderful to see so many children taking up the opportunities on offer. We had book club, cricket, gardening, jigsaw, new Year 4 netballers and the Year 3/4 football teams continue to shine!

It was fabulous to see the addition of two external opportunities for Beech Hyde in fencing and tennis. These are being provided by Paul Davis Fencing Academy and the Wheathampstead Tennis club - all the children had a great time and the feedback from the coaches was amazing! Whilst these are paid clubs, the school can apply to the JMF for funding if your child is eligible for means-tested free school meals (pupil premium funding). You may be eligible for FSM if you are in receipt of benefits or on a low income. It is worth making sure you apply, even if your child has a packed lunch or is in Reception, Year 1 or 2, as it opens doors to additional funding like these clubs. If you are unsure how to do this, please ask Mrs Pleasants in the main office.

A big shout out to the singing club who joined the Wheathampstead Community Groups Thursday Lunch Club this week. It was so lovely to hear the warm thanks and comments on the children's kindness, not only to the club members but to each other.

Another big shout out to Year 2 this week, who clearly listened well to Ms Thomas' assembly on the first day of term about showing up every day for your education as they have the best attendance in the school at 100% for the whole of the first week back! Go Year 2!

With so many exciting things happening in school it is doubly important that all children are in school on time to benefit fully from their education. The school gates open at 8.45am and close at 8.55am when school starts. Please can you ensure you are at your child's classroom on time so that they can have a calm start to the day.


